Leader: Let us praise God the Almighty One.

All: We thank you, Loving God, for so many gifts.

Leader: Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Sp

Reader: From *Christian Education* by Basil Anthony Moreau, founder of the Congregation of Holy Cross:

Education comes from two Greek words –that for child and that for leading. It is the art of helping young people to completeness; for the Christian, this means education is helping a young person to be more like Christ, the model of all Christians. From the word’s roots, education can mean to lead a young person away from ignorance and disorder. ... This idea is founded on the principles of Catholicism and really makes of education a most important work for those who try to accomplish it; this idea makes education truly the art of arts.

Leader: Let us pray *Psalm 91* together:

All: You who dwell in the shelter of the Most High,
Who abide in the shadow of the Almighty,
Say to the Lord, “my refuge and fortress,
My God in whom I trust.”

God will rescue you from the fowler’s snare,
From the destroying plague,
Will shelter you with pinions,

I will deliver them and give them honor.
With length of days I will satisfy them
And show them my saving power.

Reader: From the writings of Basil Moreau:

We can state in a word the kind of teaching we wish to impart. We do not want our students to be ignorant of anything they should know. To this end, we shall avoid no sacrifice. While we prepare useful citizens for society, we shall likewise do our utmost to prepare citizens for eternal life.
